Consent to Operate under Section 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization / Renewal of Authorization under Rule 5 of the Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling & Transboundary Movement) Rules 2016 & amendments thereafter,

[To be referred as Water Act, Air Act and HW (M&H) Rules respectively].

CONSENT is hereby granted to;

Located in the area declared under the provisions of the Water Act, Air act and Authorization under the provisions of HW (M&H) Rules and amendments thereto subject to the provisions of the Act and the Rules and the Orders that may be made further and subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The Consent to Operate is granted for period up to: 30.04.2027.
2. The Consent is valid for the manufacture of -

Special Conditions -

1. Industry shall obtain to Authorization/permission under for registration under The Maharashtra Plastics carry Bags (Manufacture & usage) Rules, 2016.
2. Industry shall print the name of party for whom the plastic packaging material (i.e. consented products) are sold/manufactured/served by you. (As per EPR).
3. Condition under the plastic Notification dated 20rd march 2018, 11.04.2018, 30.06.2018 & future amendments thereof are strictly binding to the applicant and applicant shall not alter anything or any change without permission from M.P.C. Board.

4. If any violation in above condition were observed then the said consent, then this consent will be revoked/suspended automatically without informing the applicant/consent holder.

3. CONDITIONS UNDER WATER ACT:

- (i) The daily quantity of trade effluent from the factory shall be Nil.
 (ii) The daily quantity of sewage effluent from the factory shall not exceed 0.80M³.
 (iii) Trade Effluent: Nil
 Treatment: The applicant shall provide comprehensive treatment system consisting of primary/secondary and/or tertiary treatment as is warranted with reference to influent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of the treated effluent to the following standards:
 (iv) Trade Effluent Disposal: Nil
 (v) Sewage Effluent Treatment: The applicant shall provide comprehensive treatment system as is warranted with reference to influent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of treated effluent to the following standards.

(1)	Suspended Solids	Not to exceed 100	mg/l.
(2)	BOD 3 days 27o C.	Not to exceed 100	mg/l.

- (vi) Sewage Effluent Disposal: The treated domestic effluent shall be soaked in a soak pit, which shall be got cleaned periodically. Overflow, if any, shall be used on land for gardening / plantation only.

(viii) Other Conditions:

- The authority shall provide adequate water treatment and disposal facility for generated effluent from their activity. They shall comply with provisions under the Water (Prevention and control Pollution) Act, 1974.
- The authority shall provide adequate Air pollution control arraignment at the source. They shall comply with the provisions under the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and conditions prescribed as above.
- The remediation and restoration measures shall be taken by the project proponent in case of any environmental pollution in surrounding area due to emissions / effluent in excess of the standards being discharged / emitted into the environment and violation of consent conditions and thereby causing environmental pollution.
- The industry should not cause any nuisance in surrounding area.

4. The applicant shall comply with the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Cess Act, 1977 (to be referred as Cess Act) and amendment Rules, 2003 there under

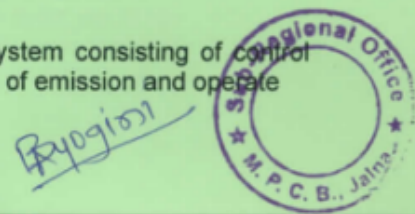
The daily water consumption for the following categories is as under:

The applicant shall regularly submit to the Board the returns of water consumption in the prescribed form and pay the Cess as specified under Section 3 of the said Act.

5. CONDITIONS UNDER AIR ACT:

- (i) The applicant shall install a comprehensive control system consisting of control equipment as is warranted with reference to generation of emission and operate



and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the level of pollutants to the following standards:

a. Control Equipment: Dust Collector of Sufficient capacity shall be provided.

b. Standards for Emissions of Air Pollutants:

1) SPM Not to exceed 150 mg/Nm³

(ii) The applicant shall observe the following fuel pattern:-

(iv) The industry shall take adequate measures for control of noise levels from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standard in respect of noise to less than 75 dB(A) during day time and 70 dB(A) during night time. Day time is reckoned in between 6 a.m. and 10 p.m. and night time is reckoned between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.

(v) Other Conditions:

- 1) The industry should not cause any nuisance in surrounding area. If nuisance occurred, industry should voluntarily stop the activity.
- 2) The industry should monitor ambient air quality regularly.

6. CONDITIONS UNDER HAZARDOUS WASTE (MANAGEMENT, HANDLING & TRANSBOUNDRY MOVEMENT) RULES, 2016:

(i) The Industry shall handle hazardous wastes as specified below.

(ii) Treatment: - NIL

1. The authorization is hereby granted to operate a facility for collection, storage, transport & disposal of hazardous waste.

a. Whenever due to any accident or other unforeseen act or even, such emissions occur or is apprehended to occur in excess of standards laid down, such information shall be forthwith Reported to Board, concerned Police Station, office of Directorate of Health Services, Department of Explosives, Inspectorate of Factories and Local Body. In case of failure of pollution control equipment, the production process connected to it shall be stopped.

7. Industry shall comply with following general conditions:

- i. The applicant shall maintain good housekeeping and take adequate measures for control of pollution from all sources so as not to cause nuisance to surrounding area / inhabitants.
- ii. The applicant shall bring minimum 33% of the available open land under green coverage/ tree plantation.
- iii. Solid waste – The non hazardous solid waste arising in the factory premises, sweepings, etc., be disposed of scientifically so as not to cause any nuisance.

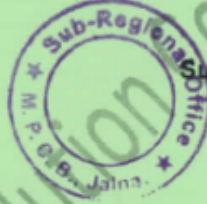

- pollution. The applicant shall take necessary permissions from civic authorities for disposal to dumping ground.
- iv. The applicant shall provide for an alternate electric power source sufficient to operate all pollution control facilities installed by the applicant to maintain compliance with the terms and conditions of the consent. In the absence, the applicant shall stop, reduce or otherwise, control production to abide by terms & conditions of this consent regarding pollution levels.
 - v. The applicant shall not change or alter quantity, quality, the rate of discharge, temperature or the mode of the effluent / emissions or hazardous wastes or control equipments provided for without previous written permission of the Board.
 - vi. The applicant shall provide facility for collection of environmental samples and samples of trade and sewage effluents, air emissions and hazardous wastes to the Board staff at the terminal or designated points and shall pay to the Board for the services rendered in this behalf.
 - vii. The applicant shall make an application for renewal of the consent at least 60 days before the date of the expiry of the consent.
 - viii. The firm shall submit to this office, the 30th day of September every year, the Environmental Statement Report for the financial year ending 31st March in the prescribed Form-V as per the provisions of rule 14 of the Environment (Protection) (Second Amendment) Rules, 1992.
 - ix. An inspection book shall be opened and made available to the Board's officers during their visit to the applicant.
 - x. The applicant shall install a separate electric meter showing the consumption of energy for operation of domestic and industrial effluent treatment plants and air pollution control system. A register showing consumption of chemicals used for treatment shall be maintained.
 - xi. Separate drainage system shall be provided for collection of trade and sewage effluents. Terminal manholes shall be provided at the end of collection system with arrangement for measuring the flow. No effluent shall be admitted in the pipes / Sewers down- stream of the terminal manholes. No effluent shall find its way other than in designed and provided collection System.
 - xii. Neither storm water nor discharge from other premises shall be allowed to mix with the effluents from the factory.
 - xiii. The consent is issued in green category CPCB direction no. B-29012/ESS (CPA)/ 2015-2016 Dated. 7/03/2016.
- 8. Applicant shall comply with Maharashtra Plastic and Thermocol Products (Manufacturer, Usage, Sale, Transport, Handling and Storage) Notification 2018 and amendment thereof.**
- 9. Applicant shall obtain Registration under rule 9 of the Plastic waste Management Rules, 2016.**
- 10. The producers shall submit/work out modalities for waste collection system based on Extended Producers Responsibility and involving state urban Development Departments, either individually or collectively, through their own distribution channel or through the local body concerned.**
- 11. The Plastic packaging material shall be more than 50-micron thickness with a minimum weight of 2 grams. The packaging material shall be printed with manufacturers details, type of plastic with code number and buy-back price.**

12. The Industry shall obtain NOC/Permission from Central Ground Water Authority towards ground water extraction if using ground water.
13. The consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/Permission from any other Govt. agencies as may deem fit necessary.
14. The Board reserves the rights to add/amend/revoke any condition in this application /consent and the same shall be binding on the applicant.
15. The industry shall obtain necessary permission from the Directorate of Industrial Safety and Health (DISH).
16. The Capital investment of the industry is Rs. 70.43 Lakhs (As per C.A Certificate submitted by industry).
